First Generation

1. Balthasar Kochanski .

Balthasar was counted in a census¹ about 1772/1773 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Balthasar appears in the The West Prussian Land Register of 1772-1773. The Land Register was essentially a survey and census of the newly acquired West Prussian province following the first partition of 1772. Balthasar, shown as Baltzer Kochanski, Krüger (innkeeper) is listed as a farmer. Balthasar's household in Lissewo is listed as consisting of one man, one woman, two daughters, one son, two male workers, and one female worker. Balthasar held five horses, four oxen, two cows, and three goats (?). Balthasar land holdings consisted of 1 Hufen and 15 Morgen. These are likely Culm (culmische) units, where 1 Hufen = 41.5 acres and 1 Morgen = 1.383 acres for a total of approximately 62.25 acres. Interestingly, most of the farmers (Bauern) of Lissewo held the same amount of land.

On the record of his marriage to Margaretha, Laurentius is shown as from Villa Skarszewy [in parafia Okonin?]

Marianna was baptized²⁹ on 13 Jan 1833 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Marianna's godparents were Mathias [illegible] and Scholastica Teykowski.

18 F ii. **(Infant) Teykowski** was born³⁰ on 15 Jan 1834 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen. She died^{31,32} on 15 Jan 1834 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

The record in the Lissewo baptismal register (with no baptism shown) is inscribed "Infans sexus faemini mortuus in lucem venit." Apparently the child died immediately after birth.

19 F iii. **Catharina Teykowski** was born^{33,34} on 22 Oct 1835 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen. She died³⁵ on 31 Aug 1836 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen. She was buried^{36,37} on 8 Sep 1836.

Catharina was baptized³⁸ on 25 Oct 1835 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Catharina's godparents were Stanislaus Kochański of Lissewo and Marianna Goryńska of Cymberk [Cymbark] in the parish of Briesen [Wąbrzeźno.]

Valentinus was baptized⁴³ on 22 Jun 1837 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Valentinus' godparents were Valentinus Prass and Marianna Gurowska, both of Lissewo.

21 M v. **Joannes Teykowski** was born^{44,45} on 28 Aug 1838 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen. He died⁴⁶ on 20 Sep 1838 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen. He was buried⁴⁷ on 23 Sep 1838.

Joannes was baptized⁴⁸ on 2 Sep 1838 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Joannes' godparents were Ludovicus Łęgowski from Pniewitte [Pniewite] and Veronica Rygielska from Malankowo.

22 F vi. **Sophia Teykowski** was born^{49,50} on 19 Aug 1839 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Sophia was baptized⁵¹ on 25 Aug 1839 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Sophia's godparents were Jacobus Niedzuriecki and Susanna Mrowińska, both of Lisewo.

23 F vii. **Agnes Agatha Teykowski** was born^{52,53} on 13 Jan 1843 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Agnes was baptized⁵⁴ on 23 Jan 1843 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Agnes' godparents were Simon Sulkowski and Joanna Woynowska, both of Lisewo.

24 F viii. **Marianna Teykowski** was born⁵⁵ on 4 Sep 1844 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen. She died⁵⁶ on 4 Sep 1844 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen. She was buried⁵⁷ on 7 Sep 1844.

Marianna was baptized⁵⁸ on 4 Sep 1844 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Marianna's godparents were Josephus [illegible] and Ewa Lewadowska, both of Lisewo.

25 M ix. **Josephus Teykowski** was born^{59,60} on 12 Feb 1846 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Josephus was baptized⁶¹ on 22 Feb 1846 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Josephus' godparents were Paulus Teykowski of [illegible] and Anastasia [illegible] of Lisewo.

26 F x. **Julianna Teykowski** was born^{62,63} on 24 Feb 1847 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Julianna was baptized⁶⁴ on 27 Feb 1847 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Julianna's godparents were Joseph Waynowski and Victoria Goralska.

Julianna's surname appears as Tejkowski in the civil record of her birth.

28 F xii. **Marianna Teykowski** was born^{65,66} on 11 Dec 1854 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Marianna was baptized⁶⁷ on 14 Dec 1854 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Marianna's godparents were Franz Teykowski from Skarszewo (?) and Marianna Matuszewska from Malankowo.
Marianna's surname appears as Tejkowski in her civil birth record.

29 M xiii. **Vincent Tejkowski** was born⁶⁸ in 1858 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

30 M xiv. **Anton Teykowski** was born⁶⁹ about 1861. He died⁷⁰ on 5 Aug 1863 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen. He was buried⁷¹ on 8 Aug 1863.

Fourth Generation

27. **Johann (Jan) Teykowski** (Margaretha Kochańska, Petrus Kochański, Balthasar) was born^{72,73,74,75} on 27 Jan 1852 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen. He died^{76,77} on 17 Jul 1887 in Klein Rehwalde Kreis Löbau Westpreußen, Germany.

Johann was baptized⁷⁸ on 2 Feb 1852 in Lissewo, Kreis Culm, Westpreußen, Preußen.

Johann's (Jan)'s father's surname appears as "Teykowski" on his baptismal record. Jan's surname likewise appears as "Teykowski" on the record of his marriage to Rosalia Jamrozy, although it appears as "Tejkowski" on the same marriage record where it was signed, apparently by him personally. The family name appears in both forms in records of the early to mid nineteenth century; as far as has been discovered, Johann appears to have been the last to use the "y" spelling.

Johann's surname appears as Tejkowski in his civil birth record.

During the timeframe of their residence in Rywaldzik (Klein Rehwalde), in the parish of Płowęż (Groß Plowenz) (1880-1887) Jan served as godfather at the baptism of at least 12 children; Rozalia as godmother for at least 5.

Johann's godparents were Michael Teykowski from Malankowo and Francesca Rygiolska from Lissewo.

Death Certificate:

"Ostrowitt on the 23rd of July 1887

Before the undersigned registrar appeared today, personally known to me, the citizen Rosalie Teykowski born Szychowska residing in Kl[ein] Rehwalde and reported that Johann Teykowski, thirty-five years old, of the Catholic religion, residing in Kl[ein] Rehwalde, born in Lysewo, husband of the indicated, of Ostrowitt, on the seventeenth of July in the year one thousand eight hundred eighty-seven at three o'clock in the forenoon [3:00 am] died and that is to say was drowned in the lake and was first found on the 21st of July.

In accordance with the master register [this] has been certified. Ostrowitt on the 23rd of July 1887.

Johann married⁷⁹ **Rozalia [Rosa] Szychowski** daughter of Michael Szychowski and Carolina Berg on 17 Nov 1877. Rozalia was born⁸⁰ on 19 Jul 1851 in Lippinki [Lippinken], Kreis Löbau, Westpreußen. She died⁸¹ on 31 Jan 1913 in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois. She was buried⁸² on 3 Feb 1913 in Holy Cross Cemetery, Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois.

Rozalia was baptized⁸³ on 20 Jul 1851 in Lippinki [Lippinken], Kreis Löbau, Westpreußen. She immigrated⁸⁴ on 3 Jul 1896 to Baltimore Maryland. She was employed⁸⁵ as House Keeper in 1900. She was counted in a census⁸⁶ on 1 Jun 1900 in Chicago Illinois at 8424 Buffalo Avenue. She was counted in a census^{87,88} on 28 Apr 1910 in Chicago Illinois at 8402 Illinois [Now Baker] Avenue.

Lippinken is now Lipinki, Biskupiec, Nowomiejski, Warmińsko-Mazurskie, Poland.

BAPTISM: Rosa's godparents were Eduardus Domaga from Wardegowo and Rosa Szychowska from Ostrow [Ostrowite].

After Rozalia's 1868 marriage to her first husband Leopold Jamrozy, the couple apparently moved to Rywaldzik, Leopold's home. No further reference to either of them is found in the Lippinken parish records. Leopold next appears in a baptismal record in the Groß Plowenz (Płowęż--about six miles from Lipinki) parish records in 1876, where he served as godfather at a baptism; the record shows him residing (presumably with Rozlia) in Rywaldzik, which is in the parish of Groß Plowenz. After Leopold's death (4 Mar 1877) Rozalia married Jan Tejkowski (17 Nov 1877). The couple continued to reside in Rywaldzik. No records of birth for her Jamrozy children have yet been found. Rozalia's 1896 passenger manifest lists her (with her name shown as Rosalie) last permanent residence as "Lippehnken" [no

doubt Lippinen] Germany. Rozalia's manifest indicates that she is going to join her son-in-law (and the Tejkowski children their brother-in-law) in South Chicago Illinois. This is probably Adam Gospodarek, who married Rozalia's daughter Anastasia Jamrozy in 1891, well before Rozalia's immigration. Both the 1900 and 1910 census population schedules indicate that Rozalia is the mother of 11 children, seven of whom are living. This would include Roman, Julian, and Anastasia Jamrozy, as well as Jan, Joanna, Walenty, and Aniela Tejkowski. Thus, it appears that all of Rozalia's surviving children as of 1900 are accounted for.

BIRTH: Sophia's birth date as indicated in her baptismal record is inconsistent with Jan's; her baptismal record contains an illegible annotation which might clarify this issue.

BAPTISM: Godparents at Sophia's baptism were Wojciech Ostrowski and Anna Koprowska.

+ 33 F iii. **Joanna (Juliana) Tejkowski** was born on 8 Jun 1881. She died about Dec 1925.

34 F iv. **Marianna Tejkowski** was born⁹¹ on 2 Feb 1883 in Klein Rehwalde [Kreis Löbau Westpreußen now Rywałdzik Poland].

Marianna was baptized⁹² on 2 Feb 1883 in Parish of St Margarethe, Groß Plowenz, Kreis Strasburg.

BAPTISM: Marianna's godparents at her baptism were Caszmir Wizlie and Paulina Tejekowa (?).

+ 35 M v. **Wincenty Tejkowski** was born on 25 Jan 1884. He died on 23 Aug 1935.

+ 36 F vi. **Aniela (Angela) Tejkowski** was born on 4 Mar 1886.

37 M vii. **Antonius Tejkowski** was born⁹³ on 2 Feb 1888 in Rywałdzik [Klein

Rehwalde Kreis Löbau Westpreußen now Rywaldzik Poland].

Antonius was baptized⁹⁴ on 2 Feb 1888 in Parish of St Margarethe, Groß Plowenz, Kreis Strasburg.

BIRTH: Antonius' birth record includes the notation "posthumous", indicating his father was deceased at the time of Antonius' birth.

BAPTISM: Antonius' godparents at his baptism were Casimirus Wyslie and Anna Jaskowik (?).

32. **Jan Tejkowski** (Johann (Jan) Teykowski, Margaretha Kochańska, Petrus Kochański, Balthasar) was born^{95,96,97} on 29 Apr 1879 in Rywałdzik [Klein Rehwalde Kreis Löbau Westpreußen] Poland. He died⁹⁸ on 13 Aug 1945 in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois. He was buried^{99,100} on 16 Aug 1945 in Holy Cross Cemetery, Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois.

Jan was baptized¹⁰¹ on 29 Apr 1879 in Parish of St Margarethe, Groß Plowenz, Kreis Strasburg. He immigrated¹⁰² on 2 Jul 1896 to Baltimore Maryland. He was counted in a census¹⁰³ on 1 Jun 1900 in Chicago Illinois at 8424 Buffalo Avenue. He was naturalized¹⁰⁴ on 26 Mar 1903 in Superior Court of Cook County, County; Chicago Illinois. He was employed¹⁰⁵ as Craneman in 1910 in Steel Mill. He was counted in a census¹⁰⁶ in 1910 in Chicago Illinois at 8426 Buffalo Avenue. He registered for the draft¹⁰⁷ from 8235 Buffalo Avenue in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois on 12 Sep 1918. He was counted in a census¹⁰⁸ on 1 Jan 1920 in Chicago Illinois at 8235 Buffalo Avenue. He was employed¹⁰⁹ as Machinist on 1 Jan 1920 in Illinois Steel W[orks]. He was counted in a census¹¹⁰ on 1 Apr 1930 in Chicago Illinois at 8420 Manistee Avenue. He registered for the draft¹¹¹ from 8420 Manistee Avenue, Chicago on 27 Apr 1942

BIRTH: Jan's birth date as indicated in his baptismal record is inconsistent with that of his sister, Sophia.

BAPTISM: Jan's godparents at his baptism were Lorenz Laskowski and Augusta Krzyzanowska.

Jan Tejkowski emigrated to the United States with his mother, Rozalia Tejkowski, brother Wincenty, and sister Angelika on the S.S. Crefeld, sailing from Bremen 18 Jun, arriving in Baltimore Maryland on 2 Jul 1896. The passenger manifest indicates the family's last residence was Lippehnken [Germany] [now Lipinki Poland.]

Johann's [as listed on the manifest] passage was paid by his mother and he was going to join his brother-in-law, probably Adam Gospodarek, husband of Rozalia's first daughter, Anastasia.

Census data indicates that he could read and write, and speak English. The family resided next door to Jan's future wife, Stanisława Plucinska, who lived at 8426 Buffalo Avenue. Jan and Stanisława were married at St. Michael Church in Chicago on 27 May 1902. Witnesses to the marriage were Joseph Ziętek and [?] Jabczynski.

In 1910 Jan applied for membership and a life insurance policy with the Polish Roman Catholic Union (PRCU). He

listed his height as 5' 8", weight as 169 pounds, occupation as "robotnik" [laborer], and place of birth as the parish of Płowenz Germany.

Jan and Stanisława later resided at 8420 Manistee Avenue in Chicago. His death certificate lists his date of birth as 29 Apr 1884 [incorrectly--the 1879 date is consistent with several other records.] His occupation is shown as retired craneman at Carnegie Illinois Steel. Jan died 13 Aug 1945 and is buried at Holy Cross Cemetery in Calumet City Illinois in Section 13.

CENSUS: The 1920 Census shows the family name misspelled as Takoski.

Jan married^{112,113} Stanisława "Stella" Plucinska daughter of Walenty Plucinski and Michalina Ziętek on 27 May 1902 in St Michael Church Chicago, Cook County, Illinois. Stanisława was born^{114,115,116} on 19 Oct 1886 in Koschmin, Stadt Kreis Koschmin, Posen, Preußen, Germany [now Koźmin, Wielkopolskie, Poland]. She died in May 1944. She was buried¹¹⁷ on 10 May 1944 in Holy Cross Cemetery, Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois.

Stanisława was baptized¹¹⁸ on 20 Oct 1886 in Koschmin, Stadt Kreis Koschmin, Posen, Preußen, Germany. She immigrated¹¹⁹ on 12 Apr 1889 to Baltimore Maryland. She was counted in a census¹²⁰ on 1 Jun 1900 in Chicago Illinois at 8426 Buffalo Avenue. She was counted in a census¹²¹ on 15 Apr 1910 in Chicago Illinois at 8426 Buffalo Avenue. She was counted in a census¹²² on 1 Jan 1920 in Chicago Illinois at 8235 Buffalo Avenue. She was counted in a census¹²³ on 1 Apr 1930 in Chicago Illinois at 8420 Manistee Avenue.

BIRTH: Apr 1889 passenger manifest reflects Stanisława's age as 11 months, thus with a birthdate of about May 1888. 1900 census shows Stanisława's birthdate as Sep 1886. The 19 Oct 1886 birthdate reflected on her baptismal record is probably the correct date.

CENSUS: The 1920 Census incorrectly lists Stanisława's name as Mary.

Clara was baptized¹³¹ on 5 Apr 1904 in St Michael Church Chicago, Cook County, Illinois. She was counted in a census¹³² on 15 Apr 1910 in Chicago Illinois at 8426 Buffalo Avenue. She was counted in a census¹³³ on 1 Jan 1920 in Chicago Illinois at 8235 Buffalo Avenue. She was counted in a census¹³⁴ on 1 Apr 1930 in Chicago Illinois at 8420 Manistee Avenue.

BAPTISM: Clara's godparents at her baptism were John Ziętek and Anastasia Jamrozy.

Clara married **Joseph Kubiak** about Jun 1933. Joseph died on 24 Nov 2004 in Waukesha, Waukesha County, Wisconsin.

40 M iii. **Emil Leonard Tejkowski** was born¹³⁵ on 21 Sep 1908 in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois. He died¹³⁶ on 16 Oct 1976 in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois. He was buried^{137,138,139} on 19 Oct 1976 in Holy Cross Cemetery, Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois.

Emil was baptized¹⁴⁰ on 27 Sep 1908 in St Michael Church Chicago, Cook County, Illinois. He was counted in a census¹⁴¹ on 15 Apr 1910 in Chicago Illinois at 8426 Buffalo Avenue. He was counted in a census¹⁴² on 1 Jan 1920 in Chicago Illinois at 8235 Buffalo Avenue. He resided¹⁴³ in Sep 1921 in Chicago Illinois at 8420 Manistee Avenue. He graduated¹⁴⁴ Sullivan School (East 83rd Street) on 25 Jun 1924 in Chicago Illinois. He was counted in a census¹⁴⁵ on 1 Apr 1930 in Chicago Illinois at 8420 Manistee Avenue.

Baptism: Emil's godparents at his baptism were Lawrence Wasniewski and Pelagia Plucinska.

Emil married¹⁴⁶ **Stella Theresa Staroch** daughter of Stanisław (Stanley) Staroch and Veronica (Weronika) Haraburda on 28 Apr 1934 in St Mary Magdalene Church Chicago, Cook County, Illinois. Stella was born^{147,148} on 1 Dec 1912 in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois.
